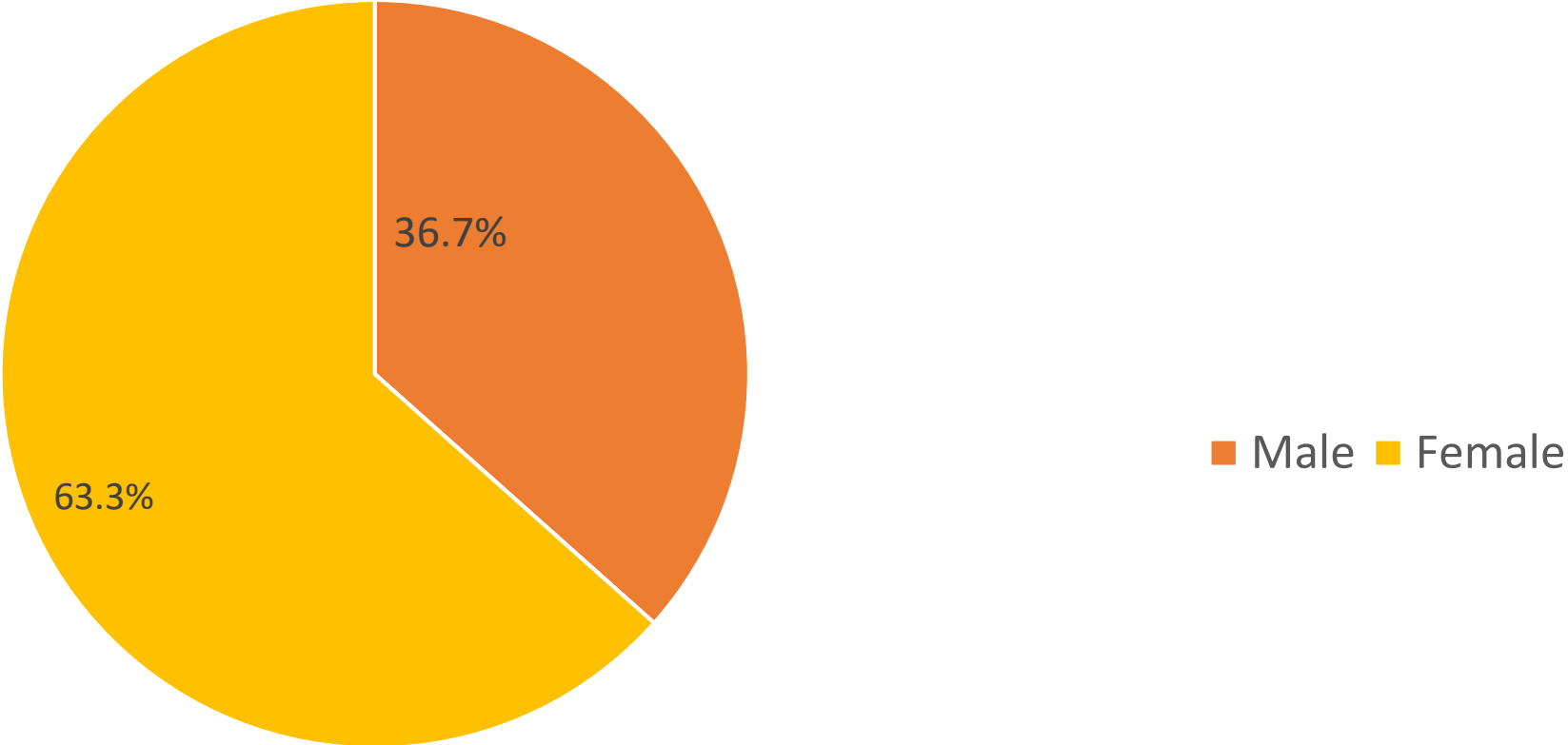
Types of Bullying



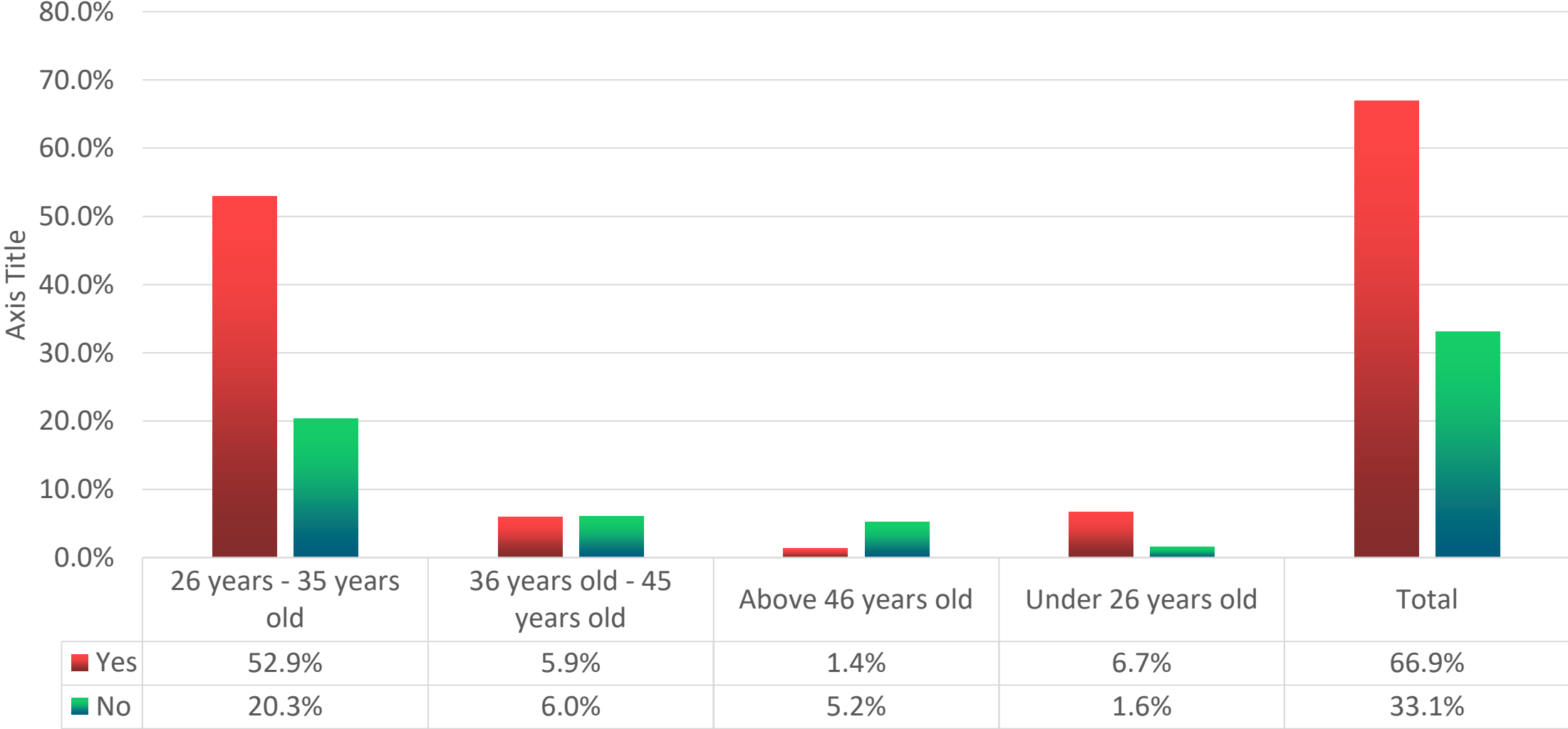

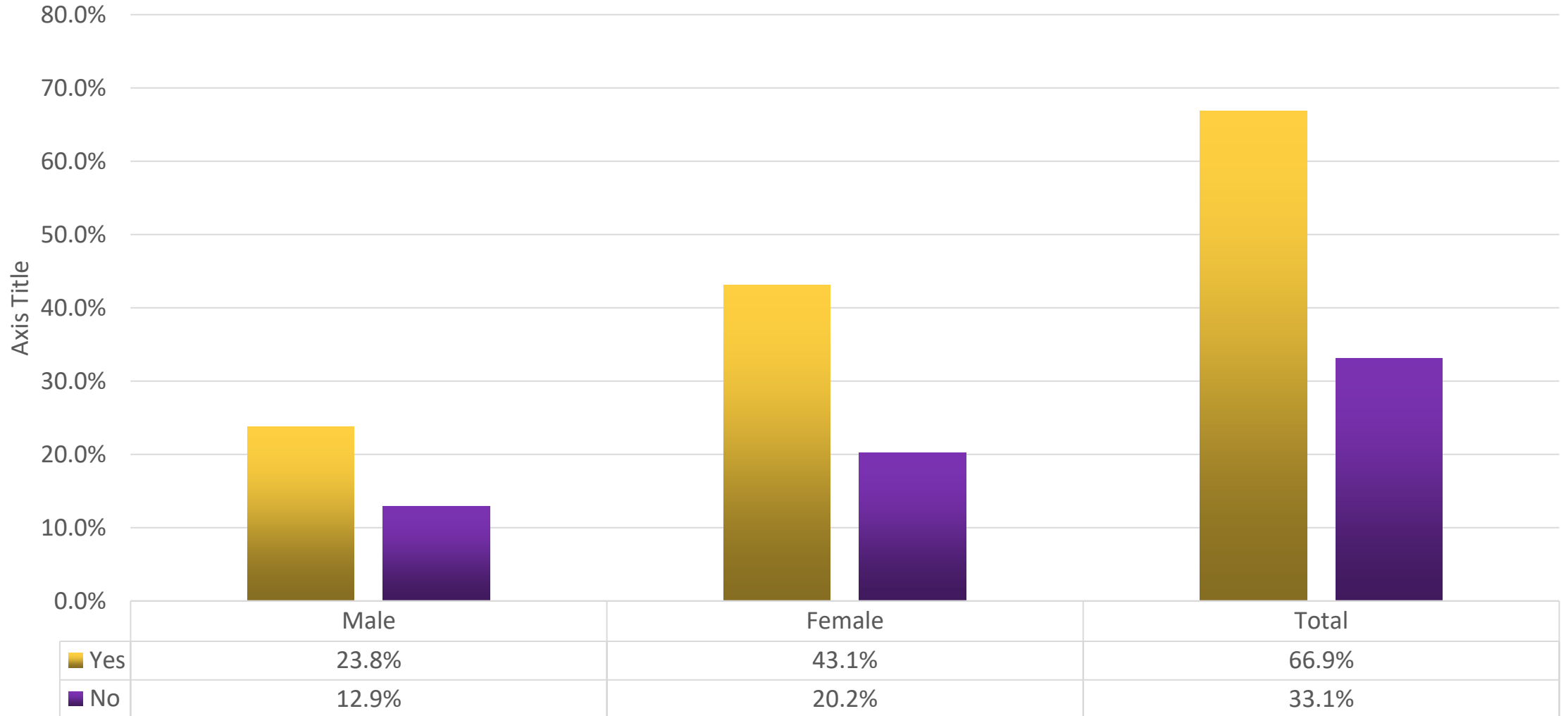
Sex distribution of Respondents



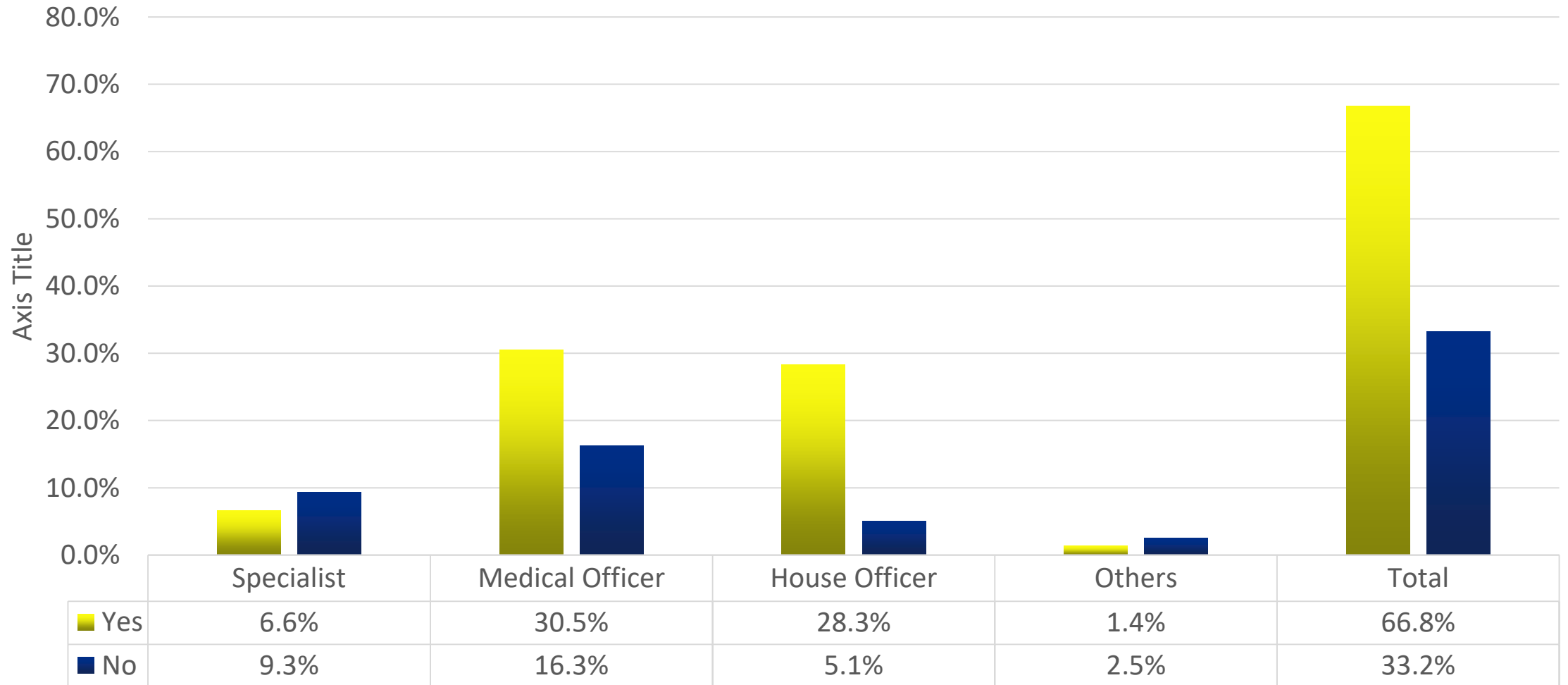
The Prevalence of Bullying /Harassment in the past year by age



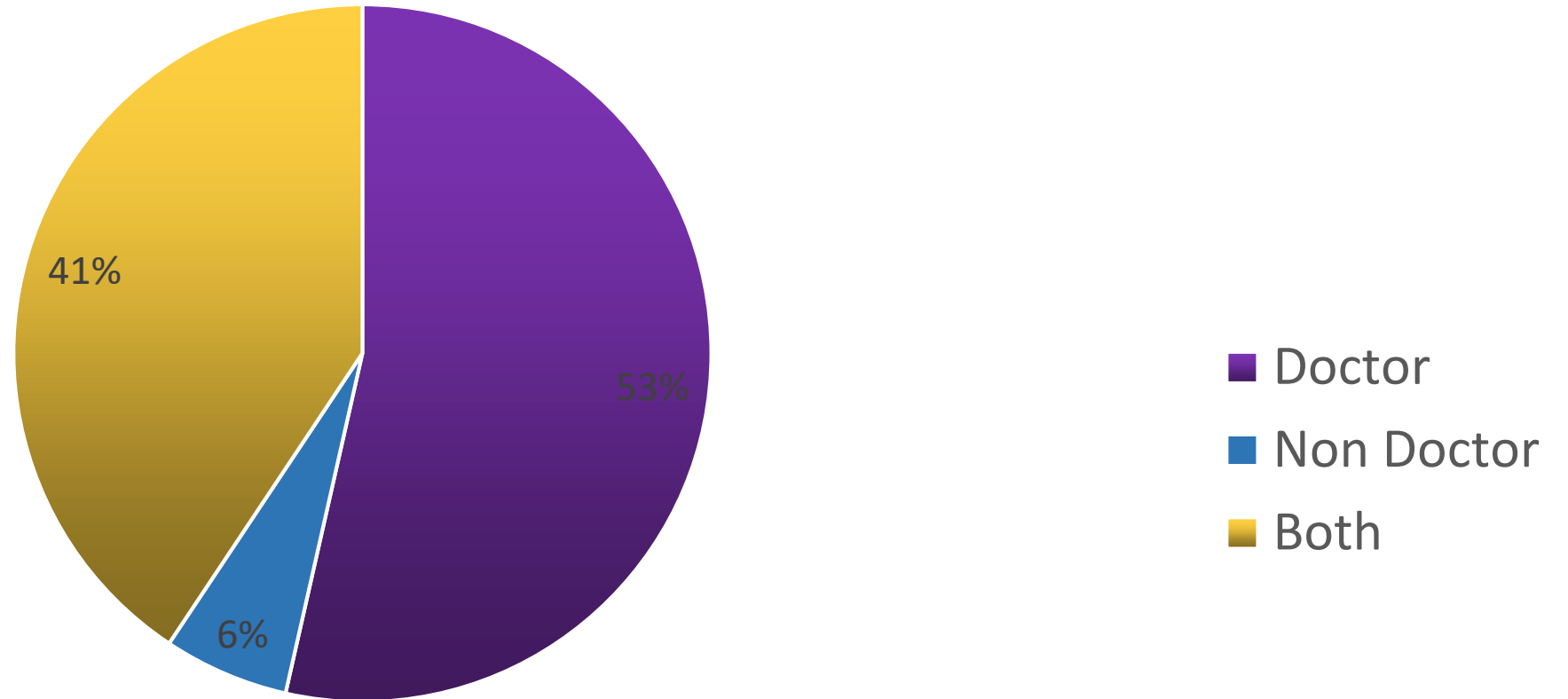
The Prevalence of Bullying /Harassment in the past year by sex



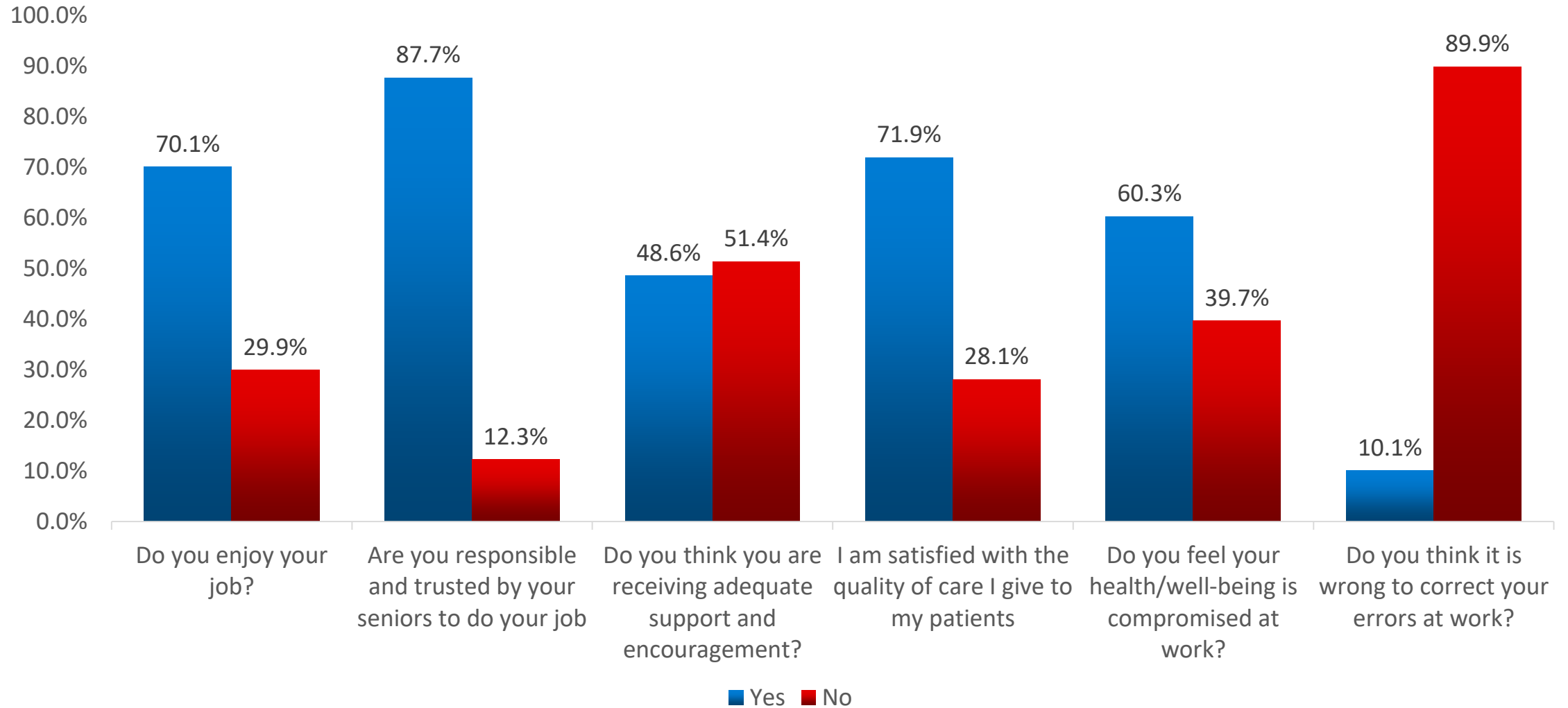
The Prevalence of Bullying /Harassment in the past year by post



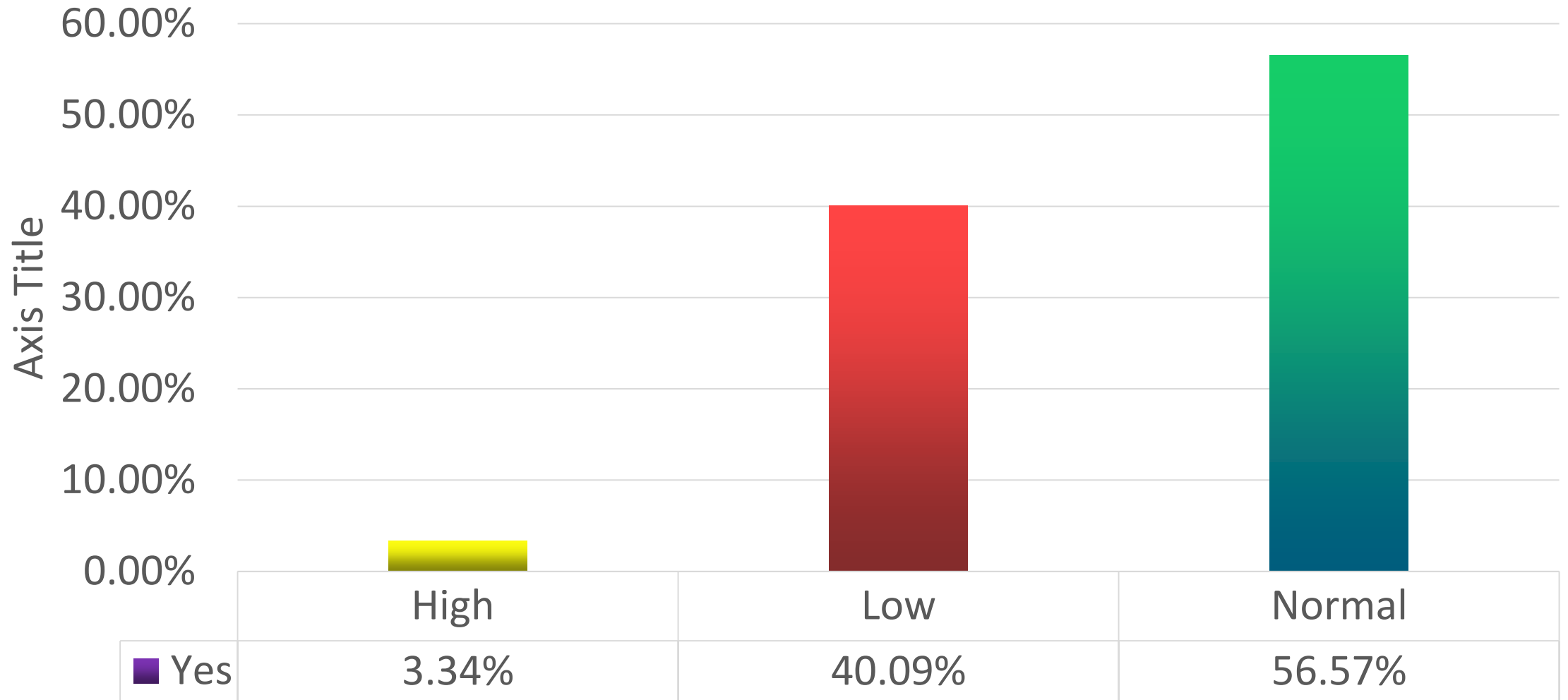

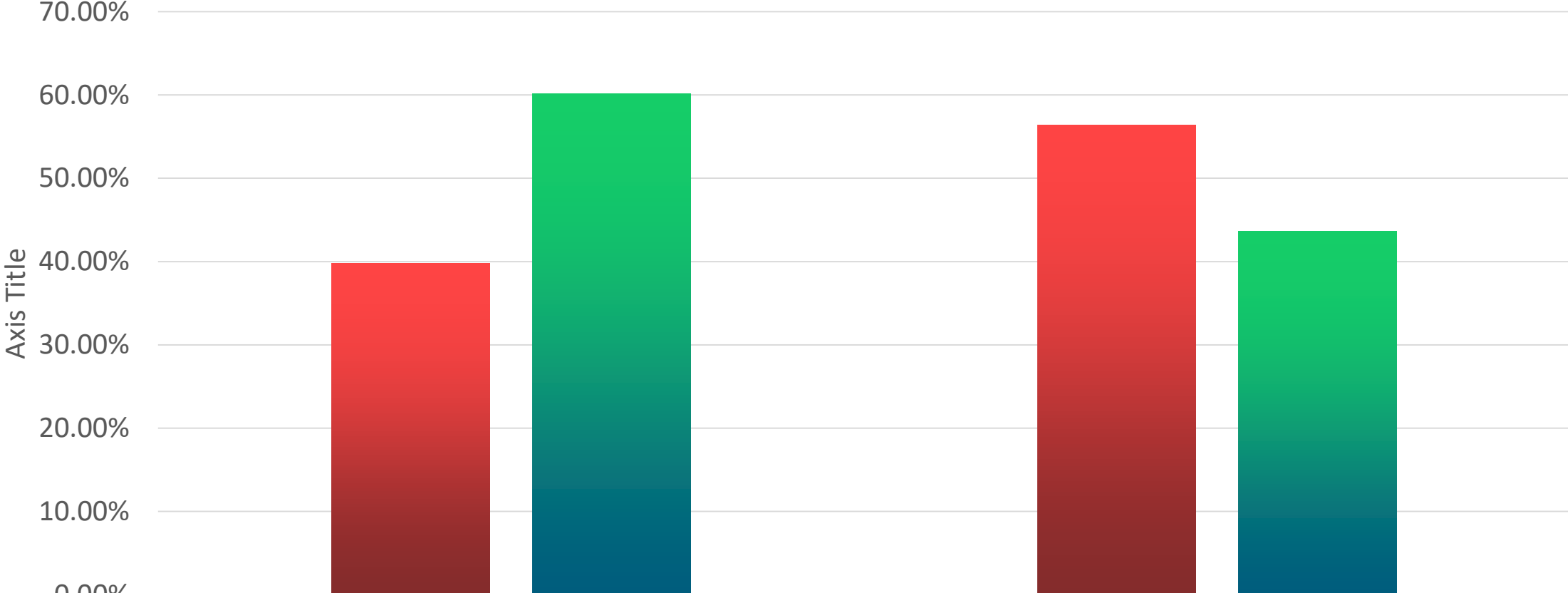
Job Satisfaction Among Respondents

The impact

- 80% of doctors lose time feeling worried
- 38% reduce the quality of their work
- 48% reduce their time at work
- 25% take it out on services users
- 20% decrease in performance
- 50% decreased willingness to help others
- 75% loss of enthusiasm at work
