ITEM 1.0: WELCOME ADDRESS

The 42nd Annual General Meeting of the SCHOMOS MMA was called to order by the Chairman of National SCHOMOS 2021/2022, Dr Vijay Ganasan at 1415H when quorum was reached.

He presented a list of achievements of SCHOMOS over the past year: - First ever KKM-MMA Townhall

- Increase in permanent position numbers and specialist training positions for contract doctors

- Gap between permanent and contract doctors
- Doctors Day 2021 which saw PPS and SCHOMOS working together
- Revised HO Guideline book
- First charity cycling event Cycle For Cancer 2022
- Women in Medicine Symposium
- Monthly Webinars
- Meet the members session online

He mentioned that we are waiting for announcements pertaining to:

- Oncall claims
- JUSA positions
- Salary review
- Subspecialty allowance review
- Senior MO promotion
- Contract doctors promotional ladder

He also highlighted and thanked the exco and NWC for membership increase to more than 2050 members (ordinary and life members) in this year. He urged everyone to build the association regardless of seniority and to not sit on the fence and be passive about issues. He thanked all those present for joining and expressed his appreciation to the 2021/2022 SCHOMOS EXCO, National Working Committee (NWC) members as well as the team at MMA HQ for their contribution and support throughout the year.

ITEM 2.0: TO ADOPT THE MINUTES OF THE 41st NATIONAL SCHOMOS ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

2.1 Dr. Sivabala invited the floor to go through the minutes of the 41st National SCHOMOS AGM and requested for a proposal to adopt the minutes. The minutes of the 41st National SCHOMOS AGM was proposed to be adopted with no amendments by Dr Divagar (Penang) / Selvaganapathi (N. Sembilan).

Two amendments were made – incoming state SCHOMOS rep from Kelantan and Dr Halimatun being from Terengganu.

ITEM 3.0: TO ADOPT THE ANNUAL REPORT OF SCHOMOS FOR THE YEAR 2021/2022

3.1 Dr Sivabala, National SCHOMOS Secretary presented the Annual report on behalf of the SCHOMOS EXCO for the year 2021/2022.

A total of 66 meetings attended up till 13/9/2022, including meetings with YBMK, MBK, JDN, SMMAMS, UMS faculty. He mentioned that we also have a representative on the council formulating the Health White Paper. 18 letters were sent out of SCHOMOS with regards to these meetings.

JDN involvement in Big 5 Forum – organized by Institution of Engineers Malaysia comprising of engineers, doctors, lawyers, accountants and pharmacists. JDN budget increased by five times – RM10000. 1^{st} International JDN conference to be held in Malaysia on 5/11/2022. JDN has been informal since 2016 but there will be a constitutional amendment proposed to formalize JDN.

Social media – MMA SCHOMOS Facebook: 11000+ followers, Instagram 4000+ followers. Berita MMA – 11 articles by exco members and one by Dr Merlinda, chair of JDN. Members are welcomed to contribute to Berita MMA. Helpdoc established in 2016 which aims to help all Malaysian government doctors. 22 cases were looked into and solved – including mental health issues, bullying, etc.

He acknowledged all state chairmen, NWC members and exco members and emphasized that the MMA is the oldest and largest association representing doctors in Malaysia.

State grants – RM42000+ were used out of RM49000. There were three rounds of fund allocation to the states: Round 1: 17/9/2021 – 30/11/2021 Round 2: 15/12/2021 – 28/2/2022 Round 3: 13/8/2021 till AGM

Prof Victor asked about the surplus of budget and the explanation of reduced traveling claims was mentioned again.

Dr Ahmad Filza proposed to the floor to appoint Dr Sivabala as an alternate representative to attend the EXCO and Council meeting on his behalf and the proposal was accepted unanimously.

ITEM 10.0: OTHER MATTERS

Dr Arul from Wilayah commented on the interview for permanent doctors from the perspective of an interviewer. Some were late for interviews, did not wear ties, unprepared

documents. Suggested that SCHOMOS have a session for teaching doctors how to prepare for interviews.

Dr Eugene from Melaka congratulated the new exco. He urged the new exco to remember the welfare of doctors in the Ministry of Defence. Dr Ahmad Filza said that there will be invitation of a rep from a doctor from MINDEF to attend the NWC meeting.

Dr Edwin from Kedah – suggestions from Dato Dr Tharma. For more HLPs slots, more placement of parallel pathways in KKM hospital, more incentive for trainers for subspecialty pathways because some are reluctant to become trainers.

Dr Kamalanathan from Wilayah suggested we push for tax deduction for parallel pathways and professional exams.

Dr Vasanthi from Sabah congratulated the outgoing and incoming team and urged everyone to continue to push for the rights of contract doctors.

Dr Sivabala (Vice Chairman) stated that MMA is always willing to help any doctor and that members are free to approach the association at any time for issues regarding welfare and career of doctors.

Dr Long Tuan stated that having a hybrid meeting is the way to go and should be continued in the years to come. He also stated that news about pension cuts and certain complaints by pensioners that say they have to pay for medication at government hospitals. He also asked why the SCHOMOS budget was smaller this year.

Dr Filza said that exco will be very supportive with regards to funding SCHOMOS activities.

Dr Timothy Cheng (Hon. Secretary) replied and stated that he has never had any issues or problems with requesting for funds from MMA for activities that will benefit the association.

Dr Selvaganapathi from Negeri Sembilan thanked Dr Vijay for his help during the past year and hoped that the welfare of long term MOs will be looked into.

Prof John George from Selangor hoped that SCHOMOS would be able to contribute to the National Health Reform paper as to prevent failure of the reform like other countries. He suggested that insurance schemes to cover out of pocket payments rather than trying to change the entire system. Dr Filza said that he was glad that Dr Koh Kar Chai is part of the Healthcare White Paper Council.

Dr Yassin from Negeri Sembilan applauded Dr Vijay and team for fighting for junior doctors rights and always finding middle ground and working with Hartal especially during the townhall session. He hopes the new exco will continue working with other medical organizations for the sake of doctors. He also highlighted the bullying issue and suggested the Helpdoc should be promoted better to ensure more doctors are aware of it.

Dr Filza said that at the end of the day we all have the same objectives to fight for doctors. Helpdoc will have many different complaints from salaries, bullying, etc. and will be channeled to the right person. He agreed that it is our role to promote Helpdoc.

Dr Leonard spoke as the outgoing treasurer and contract doctor and thanked the exco for their support over the past year. He explained the constitutional amendment being put forward by the exco regarding JDN. The amendment would be to formally recognize JDN in the constitution by including a representative in the NWC.

Dr Merlinda from Negeri Sembilan spoke to suggest that MMA start monetary assistance to help junior doctors that are starting work during the first few months where they do not get their salary and supported Dr Leonard's statement on JDN. She also hoped for more support towards parallel pathway especially in fields like occupational health.


Dr Filza thanked the floor for attending AGM and that every member, both physical and virtual will receive a RM50 Shopee voucher as a token of appreciation.



We had a good time at the retreat and are hoping for it to be made an annual event.

3.8. MMA's Career Guidance Conference

The inaugural Malaysian Medical Association's Career Guidance Conference (MMA's CGC) was held on 13th & 14th May at the Gardens Hotel Ballroom, Mid Valley City, KL. It witnessed the participation of at least 300 parents and students. This event was yet another one of MMA's CSR projects. It was held free of charge for our participants.

For the first time in Malaysia, 17 organisations comprising 23 speakers supported by private education institutions of higher learning came together on one platform with a singular aim of empowering our future through education and the pursuit of knowledge. The idea of having this conference was the brainchild of Dr Muruga Raj Rajathurai, MMA President. He felt that there's an increased rate of dropout amongst students (and young professionals) in all fields. This predicament needed to be addressed so that our students are better informed when making career decisions.

3.9. Basic Ultrasound Workshop

The Basic Ultrasound Workshop 2023 was held this year on the 9th of June at the KL Convention Centre, organised by the Women in Medicine/Schomas MMA and held concurrently with the MMA Congress of 2023. This year's collaboration was with Sains Medika, a company dedicated towards non invasive methods of imaging among others. The aims of the workshop were to provide participants with an opportunity to acquire practical knowledge in sonography that cones in useful in daily practise.

Prof Anushya Vijayanathan from UMMC, Dr Kartik Balaraman from Hospital Selayang, Dr Adienuar Ahmad Norawi from KK Bandar Kuantan and Dr Raymond Ong Yu Ying from Hospital Serdang made up an established team of esteemed speakers that delivered engaging talks. The former 3 we're joined by Dr Farhana Fadzli from UMMC, Dr Muniswaran Ganeshan from HTA KL, Dr Vicky Ho Miaw Ping from Hospital Sg Bulah, Dr Mohamed Rizwan from Hopital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah, and Mr Kumaran Govindasamy from Prince Court Medical Centre for the hands on session.

The day was a smooth flow from start to finish, having 2 sessions of the workshop that enabled the participants to see a live demonstration of sonography, followed by the hands on training. The day concluded with 8 lucky draw prize winners.

The overall success is contributed by the dedicated Secretariat and Organizing Committee from MMA and Sains Medika, as well as all the Speakers, Facilitators and Delegates that attended this event.

3.10. Webinars

In order to make the sharing of knowledge accessible and available, MMA SCHOMOS had been turning seminars into webinars even before the COVID-19 pandemic. While we are seeing more events reverting to the physical format, we are pleased to continue our webinars, as it is a good way of allowing our participants across the country to access valuable knowledge. There have been three webinars this term (quarterly), and we look forward to organizing more in due time.

3.12. Responding to Toxicologic Emergencies - A Pocket Reference

SCHOMOS was quick to support this brilliant initiative as part of our ongoing efforts in supporting junior doctors in their career and professional development. We are glad to have officially launched it at the Career Guidance Conference 2023, and hope it proves useful to our members. This is the second book SCHOMOS has published for junior doctors, the first of which was the SCHOMOS House Officer Guidebook 2022 (also spearheaded by SCHOMOS Sarawak).

PROPOSED RESOLUTION

A Resolution on Contract Doctors' Issues

The Malaysian Medical Association Section Concerning House Officers, Medical Officers, and Specialists (MMA SCHOMOS) is committed to caring for the welfare and professional interests of doctors in the public healthcare system.

WHEREAS, the issue of contract doctors in the Ministry of Health has emerged as a pressing concern since 2016, characterized by precarious employment conditions, unfair remuneration differences, and inadequate job security;

WHEREAS, contract doctors play a vital role in delivering quality and essential healthcare services, and their contributions should be acknowledged and respected;

WHEREAS, the lack of a comprehensive framework for the professional progression of contract doctors' career can lead to burnout, compromised patient care, brain drain and a negative impact on the overall healthcare system;

WHEREAS, it is crucial for MMA SCHOMOS to take a clear and proactive stance on the issue of contract doctors to advocate for fair and equitable working conditions within the medical profession;

THEREFORE, we would like to RESOLVE that MMA SCHOMOS shall through the MMA Exco:

- 1. Advocate for a comprehensive review of the employment structure for contract doctors in collaboration with relevant stakeholders, including and especially the Ministry of Health Malaysia, Ministry of Finance Malaysia, and the Public Service Department.
- 2. Lobby for the implementation of a standardized employment progression system that include fair remuneration, clearly defined job scopes, training opportunities, and appropriate benefits and leave entitlements for contract doctors.
- 3. Promote measures to enhance career progression opportunities for contract doctors, such as providing access to training, Continuing Medical Education programs, and mentorship programs.
- 4. Lobby for a conducive workplace environment that allows for holistic personal and professional growth for all healthcare workers.
- 5. Encourage the creation of support systems, such as counselling services and professional development programs, to address the mental health and wellbeing of contract doctors who often face occupational stress, in addition to anxiety surrounding the lack of job security.

- 6. Collaborate with relevant medical and media groups to raise awareness about the challenges faced by contract doctors, advocate for their rights, and promote public understanding of the importance of securing sustainable healthcare employment.
- 7. Empower the Helpdoc facility to monitor and address issues related to contract doctors, ensuring regular updates, and engagement with members regarding progress and developments in this area.
- 8. Provide frequent and transparent progress updates to members of MMA SCHOMOS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT MMA SCHOMOS, through the MMA Exco, shall actively engage with policymakers, healthcare authorities, and other stakeholders to ensure the implementation of the abovementioned initiatives, and secure a favorable outcome for contract doctors within the medical fraternity.

We urge all SCHOMOS members to support this resolution and demonstrate our commitment to addressing the concerns and welfare of contract doctors, ultimately working towards a fair and sustainable healthcare system.
