AGREEMENT

CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS LIFE MEMBERSHIP INSTALMENT PLAN BY MMA

The purpose of this plan is to encourage and facilitate ordinary members to a monthly interest free instalment contribution towards life membership.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. Applicant must be an ordinary member of MMA in benefit.
- 2. Duration of instalment is 10 months in equal monthly payments as agreed by both parties.
- 3. The amount agreed for Medical Officers within the first 2 years of service is RM1500 and all others is RM2500.
- 4. The monthly contribution of is to be banked to MMA, Alliance Bank Account No 1402-8001-0086-760 online or send a cheque payable to Malaysian Medical Association.
- 5. A member will be given a maximum grace period of not more than 60 (sixty) days to settle his dues. If he fails to pay within sixty days, his application for life membership contribution will be cancelled. If the cancellation is due to default in payment, all moneys paid will not be refunded.
- 6. If a member decides to withdraw from this scheme, he must give his request in writing to the HGS of MMA, 60 (sixty) days in advance. If a decision to refund is agreed upon a fee of RM250.00 will be deducted as administrative fee and the balance to be returned to the member. The final decision lies with the Executive Committee of MMA (EXCO).
- 7. The member will be considered an ordinary member till the full payment towards the contribution.
- 8. A receipt for each payment will be emailed to the member monthly.
- 9. The member will only become a life member on receipt by MMA of the full contribution and transfer of the total amount to the Life Investment Savings Fund.
